

 Explosive gases are created during charging. DO NOT charge near heat or flammable materials. Charge in a well ventilated area ONLY.
 Charge the battery in a dry area ONLY.
- DO NOT open the battery. Battery contains lead acid and other materials that are toxic and corrosive.
- DO NOT open the charger. Exposed wiring and circuitry inside case may cause electric shock.

- If a battery leak develops, avoid contact with the leaking acid and place the damaged battery in a plastic bag. See information in "Disposal of Battery" for proper disposal.
- If acid comes in contact with skin or eyes, flush with cool water for at least 15 minutes and call a physician.





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


Assembly of your new car is simple, provided you carefully follow the detailed diagram and refer to component part numbers to ensure they are fitted in the correct order as shown above.



Before first time use, charge the battery for at least 10 hours. Never charge the battery longer than 15 hours.


INSTRUCTION OF THE PRODUCT ASSEMBLY DRAWING




1.Install the front wheels in accordance with the instruction in the left drawing. Follow the order, mount a12mm washer, a wheel bush, the front wheel and a 10mm washer on one side of the front axle, then fix a 10mm lock nut with a wrench, and then mount the chome wheel cap (note: the two front wheels should be installed in the same way).




2.Install the rear wheel in accordance with the instruction in the left drawing. Follow the order, install the gearbox (note: gearboxes are divided into a left one and a right one), the rear wheel and a 10mm washer, then affix the 10mm lock nut with a wrench, and then mount the chrome wheel cap (note: the two rear wheels should be installed in the same way).




3.Install the windshield in accordance with the instruction in the left drawing. Install the windshield at the corresponding location at the front of the dashboard, and use four 4mmX16mm flat self-tapping screws to affix it.




4.Install the hood in accordance with the instruction in the left drawing. First, insert the plug-in units in the hood, and then install the hood at the location indicated by the arrowhead in the left drawing. Make sure everything is secure.




5.Install the hood trim strip in accordance with the instruction in the left drawing. Put the hood trim strip in front of the windshield, press it tightly against the hood, and then use four 4 mmX12mm circular self-tapping screws to affix it.




6.Install the rearview mirrors in accordance with the instruction in the left drawing. Insert the rearview mirrors (note: the rearview mirrors are divided into a left one and a right one) into the left and right holes on the two sides of the dashboard.




7.Install the steering wheel in accordance with the instruction in the left drawing. Use the screwdriver to remove the steering fixing bolt below the steering wheel, and then insert the steering wheel into the indicated location on the direction lever. As shown in FIG. B, use a 5mmX35mm steering fixing bolt to go through the direction lever and the fixation hole of the steering wheel, and then use a 5MM lock nut to affix it.



8. Connect the wire of the motor in accordance with the instruction in the left drawing, and insert plug-ins of the motor in place.



9. Install the cover plate under the seat in accordance with the instruction in the left drawing. Place the cover plate under the seat at corresponding location, and use the 4mm×12mm circular self-tapping screws to affix it.



10. Install the seat in accordance with the instruction in the left drawing. Place the seat at corresponding location above the cover plate, and use the 4mm×16mm circular self-tapping screws to affix it.


OPERATING FEATURES

Your car is fitted with 2 gearboxes containing 2 forward speeds and 1 reverse speed. The operating speed of your car can be controlled by the middle gear lever. Pushing it all the way forward will engage forward speed on high speed. Central position of gear lever will engage forward speed at low speed. Pushing your gear lever all the way back will operate reverse gear in low speed.

Your car is also fitted with an **ON/OFF** switch located on the dashboard. Switch must be in the on position to activate drive. In order to start your car, push gear lever forward into high speed position and place your foot onto the accelerator.

To stop your car, simply release your foot from the accelerator and this will engage the auto brake system. Your car is not fitted with a manually operated brake.


Your car has a large turning radius. To ensure unwanted collisions with obstacles, it is recommended that you drive your car in a wide open area until you get fully used to its handling and steering capabilities.



Thermal Fuse

Your car is fitted with a thermal overload fuse.

The function of this component is to protect the electrical circuit of your product. If the product is overloaded (refer to maximum user weight) or is used on a steep incline (not recommended) the thermal fuse will cut power supply to the motors and vehicle will stop. Thermal fuse will reset within 2 minutes and product function will resume as normal.



Charging your electric car

Battery charging input socket is located at the bottom of the seat as shown in the image left. Plug charger output socket into input socket on your car as shown. Then plug AC adaptor / Charger into a standard 240 V household power outlet. Battery should be charged for no longer than 15 hours first charge and each charge thereafter no less than 8-12 hours. Never allow your battery to run completely flat and always place battery on charger if vehicle starts to show signs of slowing down or erratic motion.

Battery charger used with the toy is to be regularly examined for damage to the cord, plug, enclosure and other parts, and in the event of such damage it must not be used until that damage has been repaired.

Charging tips

- 4.To ensure proper life span of your battery while car is in storage, it is strongly advised to charge battery fully every 3 months.
- 5.Before charging the battery check for wear or damage to the battery, charger, the connectors and other parts. If any damage is found, charger should be repaired or replaced immediately. Do not use a damaged charger.
- 6.It is normal for the adaptor to feel warm during charging, but if the charger feels very hot, stop charging and check the battery and adaptor.
