


I) Battery Troubleshooting

Operation: Use the equipped hexagonal key to unlock the seat first, then use a Phillips screwdriver to open the battery compartment. Unplug the battery connector, then use a volt-meter to check the condition of the battery.






Reading Judgment: 25.5 V ~ 26.4 V – Good condition

- 22.5 V ~ 24.0 V Recharge battery
- 21.5 V Recharge battery. If after the stipulated recharging time, voltage has not increased, then the battery needs to be replaced.
- Below 19.2 V Battery needs to be replaced.



II) Wiring Troubleshooting

Operation: There are three sets of connectors inside the battery compartment. Follow above Point (I) to remove the seat and battery cover, and then check the connections.




Reverse above procedures to re-assemble the vehicle after checking.



III) Check Chain Connection


Operation: Tip over the vehicle, then follow below steps to access the chain and check the condition.





IV) MCB (Motor Control Board) Replacement

Operation: Follow Step (I) to remove and battery cover, and then unplug all three connectors to remove the MCB completely.








IV) MCB (Motor Control Board) Replacement



- Charge the battery for 24 hours before using the vehicle for the first time. Charge the battery for 12 hours after each use.
- Charge the battery once a month, even if you are not using your vehicle.
- Do not leave the battery on the charger for more than 30hrs.

#### RENSEIGNEMENTS IMPORTANTS CONCERNANT LA CHARGE

- Charger la batterie pendant 24 heures avant de conduire le véhicule pour la première fois. Charger la batterie pendant 12 heures après chaque utilisation
- Charger la batterie au moins une fois par mois, même sile jouet n'est pas utilisé.
- Ne pas laisserla batterie branchée au chargeur pendant plus de 30 heures.


#### INSTRUCCIONES IMPORTANTES Para cargar la pila

- No deje la pila en el cargador durante más de 30 horas.


